
The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) are both in receipt of your March 6, 2009, letter requesting an amendment to the West Virginia FY 2009-12 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). This amendment adds Highway and Transit projects to the statewide program that are associated with the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

In amending the STIP, we understand that the appropriate public involvement procedures have been followed, that the STIP remains fiscally constrained and that the subject amendment was developed in accordance with the January 6, 2005 WVDOT/FTA/FHWA STIP Operating Guidelines and 23 CFR 450.

Based upon the information provided and our understanding of the projects, we hereby approve amendment #3 to the West Virginia FY 2009-12 STIP. This approval does not constitute a final commitment of Federal funds.
